Current Weather Statement


Overview:

- As of 1100 hours, Hurricane Matthew has been upgraded to a Category 4, Major Hurricane.
- Matthew is expected to continue to strengthen as it continues to approach the east coast of Florida.
- Pasco County is now under a Tropical Storm Warning.
- There is 40%-70% chance of experiencing sustained Tropical Storm Force Winds (39 mph) across Pasco County.
- Total rainfall for this storm is expected to be less than 1.3 inches, with higher amounts locally.



Hurricane Matthew NHC Path

- Sustained winds are 140 mph
- Movement Speed 14 mph Northwest
- Pressure: 940 mb
- Distance from New Port Richey Approximately 373 miles




Spaghetti Model




Hurricane MATTHEW GEFS Tracks & Min. MSLP (mb)

Center Location: 28.3 N 80.4 W Maximum Sustained Winds: 145 mph (Cat 4) Movement: 13 mph NW



Center Location: 28.9 N 80.8 W Maximum Sustained Winds: 140 mph (Cat 4) Movement: 12 mph NNW





Center Location: 27.9 N 81.4 W Maximum Sustained Winds: 145 mph (Cat 4) Movement: 13 mph NW



- Emergency Management is remains at Level 2
- Staffing EOC for 1700 hours
- Local State of Emergency as of 1000 hours
- School board closing
- Shelter operations
- Preparing for host sheltering
- Pasco County employees will be trained today to staff shelters
- Class tentatively 1500 hours today



What We Are Doing (cont.)

- West Pasco Government facilities will remain open
- 7 Sandbag locations have been opened throughout the County, including local municipalities
- Mutual Aid Requests after storm
- Fuel Status
- Response Teams
 - Tree crews, transportation, medical rescues
- Evacuation Orders
 - Voluntary for manufactured homes
- Overnight Operations
