*Please recycle.* If you get twice-a-week curbside garbage pickup, you are already paying for recycling service. You can recycle at the curb from the convenience of your home. You can "Choose & Use Your Own Container" – blue bags are no longer required. Make sure your container displays a recycling sticker. Put all your recyclables in the same container and put it out on the curb the night before your recycling pickup day. Your hauler can provide you a schedule and a sticker.

You can recycle aluminum cans, metal food cans, clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, and plastic bottles and jars coded #1, #2, #3, #4, #5 and #7. No #6 plastic. Please rinse items and remove caps before recycling.
