FINAL BUDGET HEARING

Mayor Hamilton opened the budget hearing.
Clerk Miller defined roll back rate, stated the previous year's ad valorem tax proceed and how it was generated. She stated the current year gross taxable value for operating purposes, the proposed millage rate of 1.15 mill, the rolled back rate for 2012 as 1.2954 and the current year proposed rate, as a percent change of the rolled back rate being -11.22%.

Having no discussion Mayor Hamilton read Ordinance 12-03 in its entirety.
